Prof. John Gallagher will be teaching a version of his popular "Learn to Program in Swift while Building iOS Apps", hands-on for BC Summer International Programs in our first-ever experience at the Universidad Alberto Hurtado. The campus of this Jesuit University is located in the heart of downtown Santiago. Classes will be held four days a week, we will have regular evening and Friday cultural excursions and visits to local business/technology firms. We'll have a weekend-away-from-Santiago experience to further explore Chile, and you'll have two weeks free to explore on your own, as you'd like. There will also be several opportunities to meet and make friends with students at UAH.

Students MUST have an M1 or faster MacBook laptop, as that's required for the free software (Xcode) that we'll be using for class.

Costs for the program have not yet been set, but will be available by the end of October. Expect costs in line with past, similar Boston College Summer Study Abroad experiences.
