In his recent book, *Boisi's Best*, Boston College's Andrew Prevot outlines a colloquium covering questions growing out of his first publication, *Thinking Prayer: Theology and Spirituality Amid the Crisis of Modernity*.

Prevot opens by articulating a tradition of arguments in opposition to prayer: some claim it is a sinful instruction that uses encouragement to violate, citing modern religious violence as an example. Praying from a position of victimization, critics argue, is especially for victims. It is not listening. In fact, prayer isn't protection or help. And, finally, prayer is not a response to atrocity or violence.

Andrew Prevot addresses concerns against prayer.

Prevot offers a different perspective. In a religion that has always prayed, a religious instruction that is a stable ground for victims in prayer is not an act of application or spiritualizing. It is a moral habit. Prayer has been

known to play a critical role in shaping the historical actors in the American moral and national conscience. Martin Luther King, Jr., Dorothy Day and Dietrich Bonhoeffer have all famously testified to the importance of prayer in their lives.

Prevot concludes that the way to begin making a national habit of prayer is to cultivate it in the modern world.
