Purpose of Policy

Scope

This policy applies to individuals, including the Principal Investigator (*PI) and any other person regardless of title or position who is responsible for the purchasing, contracting, design, implementation, oversight, expenditures, or reporting of sponsored programs and funds on behalf of BC. It includes non-BC collaborators or non-BC consultants.

Definitions

Indirect Costs; The portion of the total cost of a project that is not directly attributable to the project but is necessary for the institution to operate. It includes overhead costs, administrative costs, and other indirect costs.

Indirect Costs Waiver; A waiver of indirect costs for a project. It is granted when the project is deemed to be of exceptional merit and the indirect costs are deemed to be excessive.
